## PRE-TRIAL INTERVENTION AGREEMENT

On the authority of, the State Attorney in and for the Sixteenth Judicial Circuit, Monroe County, Florida, prosecution in this matter will be deferred for a period of (12)Months from date of the execution of this agreement.

The State of Florida and Roman Gastesi, agree to the following accord:

- The Defendant shall refrain from violating any law (Federal, State or Local). In 1. the event of a criminal arrest while in the program you will be subjected to automatic dismissal.
- 2. Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.191 provides that the Defendant is entitled to a speedy trial, and to be brought to trial within ninety (90) days for a misdemeanor offense and within one hundred and eighty (180) for a felony offense of when the prosecution is started. The Defendant agrees to waive this right to a speedy trial by in order to participate in this agreement.
- 3. The Defendant will report once monthly at the direction of the pretrial supervisor and will make a full and truthful report to Monroe County Probation. This report will include answers on seeking gainful employment, pursuing any courses of study, participating in any programs required by this agreement and not carrying firearms or weapons during the period of this agreement. Exclusions concerning the firearm requirement are available for Military, Law Enforcement or Security Personnel who are required to possess firearms as a condition of their employment or service. Prior authorization is required for the firearm exclusion to apply.
- The Defendant agrees to notify the Clerk of the Court and Monroe County Probation of any change in residence, employment or arrest during the period of this agreement.

- The Defendant will agree to pay Monroe County Probation a \$50.00 cost of supervision fee per month for the length of this agreement.
- 6. The Defendant shall not use intoxicants <u>to excess</u> during the course of your supervision under this agreement. You will be required to submit to random urinalysis. You may be prohibited elsewhere in this agreement from using any intoxicants during the course of your supervision.
  - 7. The Defendant agrees to the following conditions as part of this agreement:
  - a) 12 Months Supervision (can request early termination upon completion of all conditions no earlier than 3 months and with SAO approval).
  - b) \$420 Court Costs
  - c) \$1000 Cost of Prosecution & Investigation to SAO
  - d) \$500 donation to Good Health Clinic (Monroe County)
  - e) \$500 donation to FL Keys Children Shelter
  - f) 1 Completion of ICMA Ethics 101 Course
  - g) 50 hours community service

The State Attorney's Office agrees to Nolle Prosequi (dismiss) the charge(s) in this case after time set forth in this agreement if the Defendant has completed all the terms and conditions of this agreement.

- 8. If the State discovers that the Defendant has violated any law or any part of this agreement during the period of this agreement then the agreement shall be considered null and void and the State of Florida may recommence prosecution. This includes offenses committed during the period set forth below, but not discovered until that period has ended. The decision whether or not such violations may have occurred will remain in the discretionary judgment of the State Attorney's Office.
  - This agreement shall be supervised by Monroe County Probation.
- 10. This is the entire Agreement between the parties. The Defendant acknowledges that the Defendant is entering this agreement freely and voluntary, and that by signing this agreement the Defendant certifies that the Defendant has read, understands and agrees to comply with all the terms and conditions of this agreement.
